II. To Judge the Living and the Dead

679 Christ is Lord of Eternal Life. Full right to pass definitive Judgment on the works and hearts of men belongs to Him as Redeemer of the world. He "acquired" this right by His Cross. The Father has given "all Judgment to the Son."587 Yet the Son did not come to Judge, but to save and to give the Life He has in Himself.588

1 Corinthians 1:18 - "For the word of the cross, to them indeed that perish, is foolishness; but to them that are saved, that is, to us, it is the Power of God."

2 Corinthians 5:10 - "For we must all be manifested before the Judgement Seat of Christ, that every one may receive the proper things of the body, according as he hath done, whether it be Good or evil."

After this He disappeared, and I also comprehended that it is True that Jesus Loves the Cross, but many times it is man himself that incites and provokes Jesus to give him the Cross. In fact, if man were Ordered in the Order of God, of himself and of creatures, not seeing any disorder in him, the Lord would remain at Peace and would give him Peace.
