

*Hypocrisy*  
*Gospel Reading for October 14*  
*With Divine Will Truths*  
*Saint Luke 12:1-7*

*At that time: So many people were crowding together that they were trampling one another underfoot. He began to speak, first to his disciples, "Beware of the leaven--that is, the hypocrisy--of the Pharisees.*

*There is nothing concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known.*

*Therefore whatever you have said in the darkness will be heard in the light, and what you have whispered behind closed doors will be proclaimed on the housetops.*

*I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body but after that can do no more.*

*I shall show you whom to fear. Be afraid of the one who after killing has the power to cast into Gehenna; yes, I tell you, be afraid of that one.*

*Are not five sparrows sold for two small coins? Yet not one of them has escaped the notice of God.*

*Even the hairs of your head have all been counted. Do not be afraid. You are worth more than many sparrows."*

**1039** *In the presence of Christ, who is Truth itself, the truth of each man's relationship with God will be laid bare.<sup>626</sup> The Last Judgment will reveal even to its furthest consequences the good each person has done or failed to do during his earthly life: All that the wicked do is recorded, and they do not know. When "our God comes, he does not keep silence." . . . he will turn towards those at his left hand: . . ." I placed my poor little ones on earth for you. I as their head was seated in heaven at the right hand of my Father—but on earth my members were suffering, my members on earth were in need. If you gave anything to my members, what you gave would reach their Head. Would that you had known that my little ones were in need when I placed them on earth for you and appointed them your stewards to bring your good works into my treasury. But you have placed nothing in their hands; therefore you have found nothing in my presence."<sup>627</sup>*
