

Feast Day of St. Nicholas *December 6*

Nicholas was born in Asia Minor (Greek Anatolia in present-day Turkey) in the Roman Empire, to a Greek family^{[11][12][13]} during the third century in the city of Patara (Lycia et Pamphylia),^{[14][15]} a port on the Mediterranean Sea.^[15] He lived in Myra, Lycia^[16] (part of modern-day Demre), at a time when the region was Greek in its heritage,^[15] culture, and outlook and politically part of the Roman diocese of Asia.^[15]

In 325, he was one of many bishops to answer the request of Constantine and appear at the First Council of Nicaea; the 151st attendee was listed as "Nicholas of Myra of Lycia".^[17] There, Nicholas was a staunch anti-Arian, defender of the Orthodox Christian position,^[18] and one of the bishops who signed the Nicene Creed.^[19] Tradition has it that he became so angry with the heretic Arius during the Council that he struck him in the face.^[20]
